NOUN PHRASES


A noun phrase is a noun



accompanied by modifier to describe it so we can be more specific.

Look at the examples: The bus I take to school is yellow

In this case the noun phrase is the bus, but we can put more information on that noun phrase to make it more specific:



We would say ...

I take a big diesel bus to school : ADJETIVE

That huge public bus takes me to school: DEMOSTRATIVE

The yellow bus with painted lines takes me to school: PARTICIPLE
